Theme: Your Choice On Loving God Determines Your Destiny.

The Foundation For Your Choice And Destiny.

- 1. God's unconditional, everlasting love for you.
- 2. The reality of your choice.

The Results Of Your Choice On Your Destiny.

- 1. Acceptable or unacceptable worship. (4:3-7; Hebrews 11:4, 1 John 3:12)
- 2. Love or hatred for others. (4:8, 23-24)
- 3. The right or wrong moral standards. (4:8, 19, 23-24)
- 4. Sensitive fear or callous pride regarding sin. (4:13-14, 23-24)
- 5. The right or wrong source for your sense of self-worth. (4:20-21, 26)
- 6. Walking with God or being judged by God. (4:16-24; 4:25 5:32)

In My Life This Week

(As you use this daily guide, write out your observations and responses on a separate piece of paper and save them with this sheet for reference.)

Monday. Read Genesis chapters 4 & 5, thinking of the central truth we focused on yesterday that your choice on loving God determines your destiny. Take note of the choices people made in these chapters. Think of your own choices today, and in the last few days.

Tuesday. All of us choose to believe and love God, or not to do so. The choice is critical and the affects are significant. Today review the first two results: acceptable or unacceptable worship and love or hatred for others. Read the references and check any notes you made on Sunday. If you are a believer, but your love for and obedience to God are marred by things you have not, or are not dealing with, it is affecting your worship and relationships.

Wednesday. Today review the next two results of the choice to love or not love God as we should: the right or wrong moral standards and sensitive fear or callous pride regarding sin. As you examine yourself, what do you see? If there are things needing attention, go to God and deal with them now.

Thursday. Today review the last two results of the choice to love or not love God as we should: the right or wrong source for your sense of self-worth and walking with God or being judged by God. On these two specifics, and all of the six, realize that you're your day by day choices have a significant impact on your spiritual life.

Friday – Saturday. On Sunday we will be looking at Genesis chapters 6-9, which deal with Noah and the flood. Try to take the time to read the four chapters in preparation for our time together.
